Red Twig Dogwood

Cornus sericea baileyi

- ✿ Upright
- ✿ Bright red stems
- ✿ White flower clusters
- ✿ Porcelain blue fruit
- ✿ Shade tolerant



Ninebark

Physocarpus opulifolius var.

nugget

- ✿ Golden yellow foliage turns lime green then bronzy in the fall
- ✿ Will grow to 6' with dense branching habit



Yellow Twig Dogwood

Cornus sericea flaviramea

- ✿ Upright shrub
- ✿ Yellow twigs similar to Red Twig dogwood
- ✿ Interesting winter color



Dwarf Ninebark

Physocarpus opulifolius

nanus

- ✿ Small leaves
- ✿ White blooms
- ✿ Dense branching habit
- ✿ Shade tolerant
- ✿ Low maintenance for difficult areas



Gray Dogwood

Cornus racemosa

- ✿ 10'x10' spreading shrub
- ✿ Distinct gray older stems
- ✿ Great for naturalizing areas with poor soil, wet or dry



Pink Diamond Hydrangea

Hydrangea paniculata 'Pink Diamond'

- ✿ Grows to 8'
- ✿ Creamy white bloom clusters turning to pink in late summer
- ✿ Best growth and flowering in full sun



Cornelian Cherry Dogwood

Cornus mas

- ✿ One of the earliest shrubs to bloom
- ✿ Yellow flowers in the spring
- ✿ Can be trained to be a small tree



Chantilly Hydrangea

Hydrangea paniculata

'Chantilly'

- ✿ Dark green leaves
- ✿ 8' shrub
- ✿ Large cone shaped white blossoms well into the fall



Winterberry Holly

Ilex verticillata

- ☼ Deciduous upright shrub
- ☼ Brilliant red fruit from late summer well into winter
- ☼ Native to wet soil, does well in light loams
- ☼ Useful in wetland restoration landscaping and wildlife habitat
- ☼ Male and female plants needed for fruit
- ☼ Seed-grown plants not sexed



Nannyberry

Viburnum lentago

- ☼ Open shrub to small tree
- ☼ Creamy white bloom clusters on branch tips in late spring
- ☼ Good wildlife value



Carolina Rose

Rosa Carolina

- ☼ Upright, suckering stems form thickets along streambanks, wetlands, border areas
- ☼ Light to deep pink blooms form small scarlet hips useful for wildlife



Black Chokeberry

Aronia melanocarpa

- ☼ 2'-6' shrub
- ☼ White flowers
- ☼ Black berries
- ☼ Red autumn color
- ☼ Grows well in most soil conditions



Japanese Tree Lilac

Syringa reticulata

- ☼ Excellent small shade or street tree
- ☼ White showy flower clusters



Purple Smokebush

Cotinus coggygria 'Purpureus'

- ☼ Purple leaves
- ☼ Feathery smoky pink blooms
- ☼ Drought tolerant
- ☼ Ornamental small to large shrub



American Cranberry Bush

Viburnum trilobum

- ☼ One of the best northern native shrubs
- ☼ Grows to 12'
- ☼ Red autumn foliage
- ☼ Scarlet berries



Arrowwood Viburnum

Viburnum dentatum 'Blue muffin'

- ☼ Grows to 15'
- ☼ Glossy foliage in autumn
- ☼ Fast growing
- ☼ Good for background screen
- ☼ Wildlife habitat in any soil
- ☼ Birds love the blue fruit
