

# **2007 Hazardous Products Collections for Small Businesses**

Cape Cod towns invite you to participate in this year's household hazardous products collections if you need to dispose of hazardous products from your small business. Many towns accept reasonable amounts of small business waste at no cost. The cost of participating is minimal in towns that do charge. The schedule on the back of this letter lists 2007 collection dates, times, locations and local contacts to call if you have questions about the collections. You may participate in collections in your town, or in other towns at cost, if you call at least two weeks in advance of the collection date to discuss the type and quantity of materials you plan to bring. Our contractor cannot accept acutely hazardous materials at household hazardous products collections, so it is important that you notify us in advance. We will send you a bill of lading and the cost for disposing of your materials.
